2. Those who have falsely applied for change registration cannot participate in voting and can be punished (up to 3 years of imprisonment or up to 5 million KRW in fine) in accordance with Article 247 of the "Public Official Election Act".

※ Tips

1. For the "**Personal Information**" field, please enter the current personal information of the applicant.
2. For the "**Name**" field, you must accurately enter the name as shown in the family relation register (family register)..
3. For the "**Canceled Resident Registration Number**" field, the canceled resident registration number must be entered for a person who had a resident registration number, and the date of birth and gender must be entered for a person who never had a resident registration number.
4. For the "**Names of Parents**" field, those who never had resident registration number must enter the "Father's Name or Mother's Name" shown in the family relation register (family register) in order for accurate confirmation of citizenship/identification and place of registration (origin of domicile) .
5. For the "**Final Address in Korea**" field, the "Final Address in Republic of Korea" must be entered for people who had a resident registration number. For people who never had a resident registration number, the "Place of Registration (Origin of Domicile)" shown in the family relation register (family register) must be written.
6. For the "Overseas Address" field, the location where you can receive mail from the residing country must be entered using the Roman alphabet or English in uppercase (local language can be used additionally), and e-mail address and phone numbers (country code - area code - phone number) such as home/office and cell phone number must be written in the ( ) of overseas address to enable contact from the residing country.  
 You must fill in the overseas address, e-mail address, and phone number accurately because they are used to provide various election-related information/materials such as political party/candidate information prepared/sent by the National Election Commission, notification of voter list registration, guide to appeal application, and voting time/location/requirements.
