* Overseas absentee declaration and overseas voter registration can be done by submitting the declaration/application to an overseas diplomatic mission (via in person, mail, or e-mail) or via the website (<https://ova.nec.go.kr>).

※ Note

1. Because this declaration/application is read by a machine, please take caution not to damage it for example by folding or tearing the document.
2. Because incorrect information in the declaration/application can lead to disadvantages for the applicant (non-registration as overseas voter, inability to receive election information, etc.), you must fill in all information legibly and accurately.
3. Those who have falsely declared/applied or those who have not been deemed to have declared/applied on one's own intention cannot participate in voting and can be punished (with up to 3 years of imprisonment or with up to 5 million KRW in fine) in accordance with Article 247 of the Public Official Election Act.

※ Tips

1. You need to mark "**Oversees Absentee Declaration Form**" if you have a resident registration card and you need to mark "**Oversees Voter Registration Form**" if your resident registration card was cancelled or if you have never had a resident registration card.
2. For the "**Name**" field, you must write the name as shown in your passport (including English name).
 However, if the name is differently registered on the passport than the family relations certificate (family register), you must write the name on the family relations certificate (family register).
3. For the "**Classification by Identity**" field: If you currently have a resident registration card, mark the corresponding field and enter the "**resident registration number and the address as shown on the resident registration card**"; if your resident registration card was cancelled, mark the corresponding field and enter the "**cancelled resident registration number and final address in Republic of Korea**"; and if you have never had a resident registration card, mark the corresponding field and enter the "**date of birth and place of registration (domicile)**" as shown on the family relations certificate (family register) and mark the corresponding field of "**Gender**."
4. For the "**Names of Parents**" field, those who have never had a resident registration card must enter the "**Father's Name**" or "**Mother's Name**" shown in the family relations certificate (family register) for accurate confirmation of citizenship/identification and place of registration (domicile).
5. For the "**Phone Number**" and "**Cell Phone Number**" fields, phone numbers (country code - area code - phone number) such as home/office and cell phone number must be written to enable contact from the residing country.
 Because the phone number and cell phone number are used for sending instructions such as the confirmation of overseas absentee/overseas voter criteria, confirmation of mail delivery, voting time/location and for providing other election information, you can write down a phone number in Korea that can be contacted if you do not have a foreign number.
6. You must fill in the "**E-mail**" field because it is used to provide various election-related information/materials such as the political party/candidate information prepared and sent by the National Election Commission, the notification of overseas voter list registration, results of an appeal application, and voting time/location/requirements.
7. For the "**Overseas Address**" field, the location where you can receive mail from the residing country must be accurately written inside the dotted line using the Roman alphabet or uppercase letters (Local language can be written additionally).
 However, a diplomatic mission can be reported as your overseas address to receive mail for reasons such as work/profession/relocation/unclear address/poor mailing system of the residing country. In this case, after marking , only enter the name of the public office in the "Address" field.
8. For the "**Diplomatic mission where you wish to cast your ballot**" field, write the name of the diplomatic mission where you wish to vote at during the overseas voting period.
9. For the "**(Declarant)/(Applicant)**" field at the end, you must write your name and sign or seal.
